

Both the Old and New Testaments emphasize the centrality of loving God and our neighbor. In the first reading, we hear Moses stressing the importance of this in one of the final speeches of his life. In the Gospel, Jesus' parable of the Good Samaritan expands the understanding of "neighbor" to include those we might consider strangers or even enemies, and "love" modeled on his example of selflessness and sacrifice.

Moses entreats the people to *return to the Lord, your God, with all your heart and all your soul*. Paul writes of Christ as *the firstborn of all creation*, who reconciled all things in himself. In the Gospel, Jesus converses with a scholar of the law and commands him for knowing the law. He then uses the parable of the Good Samaritan to challenge the scholar to treat everyone with mercy.



St. Benedict is believed to have been born around 480, as the son to a Roman noble of Norcia and the twin to his sister, Scholastica.

What is Saint Benedict best known for?

St. Benedict was a religious reformer who lived in Italy in the late 400s and early 500s. He is known as the **“father of Western monasticism,”** having established a Rule that would become the norm for innumerable Christian monks and nuns. He is the patron saint of Europe.
